VANDALISM / SAFETY

Amberwood residents were recently notified of vandalism in Peachtree Farms via a yellow flyer. In an effort to deter vandalism and burglaries here a few simple tips and reminders!

There are so many simple and inexpensive ways to make your home look less inviting to burglars.

The main idea is to try and think like them, so you can determine what areas of your home and yard are less secure. You know your house better than anybody, but it helps to take an objective view of it to determine the weak points of entry and potential issues.

• Always make sure your house is well-lit on the outside, most importantly in the entry-way.

• Don't let mail, news papers or flyers accumulate while you're away, tipping off criminals.

• Have the post office hold mail, have newspapers suspended, and have a neighbor or friend clear away flyers.

• To a burglar, an empty trash can may mean you're away.

- Always lock your vehicle. If possible, park your vehicle in a well-lit area as well.
- Prune overgrown trees and shrubs to eliminate hiding places for intruders
- Almost one third of all burglaries happen without using force, so the thief gained entry through an unlocked door or window.
- Make sure your alarm system is properly installed and working correctly.



- Be a good neighbor and keep an eye out for your neighbor's home as well.
- Don't leave valuables in sight through windows, where they will tempt burglars

DID YOU KNOW...

The highest percentage of burglaries occur during the summer months of June, July and August between the hours of 9am-3pm. This is when most people are away from their homes at work or on vacation!
